During these training days and evenings you will have the opportunity to improve your driving knowledge and practice your skills in a controlled environment. To register to any of these events you will need a reference either from the Bimmershop or from the Viper Club of America. Registration is only accepted by reference. We want to insure that all participants are high quality. It is not your car that counts but your personality!

EVENT RULES

- If you are interested in participating in any of these events or all of the events, please return the registration form filled out along with your check as soon as you can. The available places are limited !
- **You can register right away for all of the lapping events or just to one of them. When you write your check please make the check for the total amount of the events that you will participate in. We will not provide any discount for multiple registrations. You have to pay the full cost of each event. Because of the rarity of this type of event we forecast a quick sale out of the available places.**
- If you wish to cancel your participation, we must receive your cancellation 4 weeks before an event takes place. Cancellation must be approved by organizers before it takes effect. Organizers can refuse cancellation any time for any reason. Organizers can impose cancellation fee at their will.
- **According their driving skills, participants will be divided into different groups. We welcome all drivers from beginners to professionals. There is place for everyone.**
- We are anticipating 20 Vipers and 20 other performance cars to participate in our events
- You can invite your friends to participate in these track events! They will have to register the same way as Viper and BMW owners and will have to pay the same registration fee.
- Final schedule will be published two weeks before each event. It will indicate your assigned lapping group and supervisor.
- It is not required to own a Viper or a BMW to participate in these events.
- We offer minimum 2 hours lapping per night and 3 hours lapping for day time to all registered drivers.
- We will offer light snack and drinks at the track.
- You can have up to three cars registered for these events, if approved by organizers. Our price is per driver.
- All level of drivers are welcome: from beginners to professional racers.
- We will assign you a lapping group according to your driving skills/experience.
- We accept no registered race cars if you own a racing license and/or if you have a proof that you can drive it.
- Unfortunately we can't accept SUV for this event. Convertible cars have to be equipped by at least a safety rollbar.
- You need to wear a helmet at all time on the track. **Don't forget to bring your helmet. We can't provide or rent any helmet.** Minimum standard for helmet: M / SA / Snell2000. SA 95 helmets will not be accepted.
- **At Mont-Tremblant the noise limit is 92 dB on a maximum acceleration pass at the distance of 50 feet. Your car must be equipped by an appropriate exhaust system.**
- **At Mirabel there is no noise limitation.**
- You can invite up to 3 visitors per registered driver. Visitors must sign a liability release form.
- No spectators in the pits other than your 2 invited guests. You will be responsible for them !
- No minors on the track any time.
- Minors will have to be approved in the pits. We require two adults per children!
- You will have to certify that your car is in good condition for the track and you will have to sign a liability waiver form as you access the facility gate.
- We strongly encourage you visiting your local dealer to inspect your car and to prepare it for tracking. We also suggest you changing your break oil prior to this event.
- The event will take place even under rain. Please have the appropriate rain tires available for your car. Slick tires will not be accepted on a wet track. Michelin Pilot Sport tires are excellent for this event.
- Drivers must register and sign a liability release form at the registration area prior to entering the track facility
- Drivers must attend the scheduled driver's meetings and briefings about the rules on the track [schedule will be published later]
- Seat belts must be worn at all times
- Pit lane speed is limited to 10 km/h. [strictly enforced]
- Organizers reserve the right to prevent anyone from accessing the track facility and lapping on the track.
- Organizers reserve the right to exclude any driver for any reason before and during the event.
- You are free to contract any sponsorship on your car or Automobile Association for this event. There is no return of any kind to provide to the Organizers.

To register, you must be 18 years or older and hold a valid driving license with at least 2 years of driving experience. Except for instructors or drivers with a racing license, all cars must have two seats of the same type, a dashboard, and equivalent seatbelts/harnesses for both driver and passenger. Racing harnesses are forbidden if the car is not equipped with a roll-cage or a roll-bar (Viper GTS ACR with OEM racing harnesses is allowed). SUV's are not allowed. Race cars are only accepted in the advanced and instructor groups. Open-wheel (e.g. Caterham) and three-wheel cars (e.g. T-Rex) are not allowed in any group. All participants must certify that proper technical inspection was done on their cars. The Viper Club reserves the right to refuse access to any car deemed unfit for track use. M and SA Snell95 (and up) helmets are required. DOT helmets will not be accepted. Drivers of cars with stripped interiors or full roll-cages must use an SA helmet. . This event is not a racing school. Under no circumstances will timed laps be permitted. If you have doubts about the acceptability of your car, call the organizers. **DO NOT** bring your car to the track and try to plead your case. If you do and your car is determined to be unacceptable, then you will not be allowed to run and your registration fee will not be refunded. **Should you have any questions regarding technical rules or should you need clarification regarding your car please contact Mr. Sebastien Rochon at info@bimmershop.ca**

Your certified automobile dealer can provide all the help required to prepare your car for lapping. We are not able to do this technical inspection/preparation for you. You will have to certify that this inspection was done properly.

- Noise limitation: *max 92db at 50 feet under acceleration*
- Break Rotors: *No cracks or chips*
- Break Pads: *Proper thickness*
- Break Fluid: *System bled and clean fluid*
- Shock absorbers: *Good condition*
- Stabilizer bars: *Proper mounting and attachment*
- Wheel bearing: *No play and noise*
- Tires: *No cracks and no more than 40% worn, H speed rating is minimal for this event*
- Seat Belts: *Fully functional and not modified, using factory mounting points*
- Seat mounting: *Proper mounted and secured*
- Interior: *No loose items in car and in trunk*
- Body panels: *Properly attached*
- Underbody panels: *Properly attached*
- Rear spoiler or wing: *Properly attached*
- External lighting: *Operational*
- Battery: *Properly attached*
- Radiator: *No leaks and cracks in hoses*
- Fluids: *In good condition and at proper levels*

RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

Covering the Viper Club Open House day events in Mirabel and Mont-Tremblant

In consideration of being permitted to enter for any purpose any RESTRICTED AREA (herein defined as including but not limited to the racing surface, pit areas, infield, approach area, and all walkways, concession's and other areas appurtenant to any area where any activity related to the event shall take place), or being permitted to compete, officiate, observe, work for, or for any purpose participate in any way in the event, THE UNDERSIGNED, for himself his personal representatives, heirs, and next of kin, acknowledges, agrees and represents that he has, or will immediately upon entering any of such restricted areas, and will continuously thereafter, inspect such restricted areas and all portions thereof which he enters and with which he comes in contact, and he does further warrant that his entry upon such restricted area or areas and his participation; if any, in the event constitutes an acknowledgment that he has inspected such restricted area and that he finds and accepts the same as being safe and reasonably suited for the purposes of his use, and his further agrees and warrants that if, at any time, he is in or about restricted areas and he feels anything to be unsafe, he will immediately advise the officials of such and will leave the restricted areas.

HEREBY RELEASES, WAIVES, DISCHARGES AND COVENANTS NOT TO SUE the promoter, participants, racing association, sanctioning organization or any subdivision thereof, track operator, track owner, officials, car owners, drivers, pit crews, any persons in any restricted area, promoters, sponsors, advertisers, owners and lessees of premises used to conduct the event and each of them, their officers and employees, all for the purposes herein referred to as "releasee", from all liability to the undersigned, his personal representatives, assigns, heirs, and next of kin for any and all loss or damage, and any claim or demands therefore on account of injury to the person or property or resulting in death of the undersigned, whether caused by the negligence of the releasee or otherwise while the undersigned is in or upon the restricted area, and/or, competing, officiating in, observing, working for, or for any purpose participating in the event.

HEREBY AGREES TO INDEMNIFY AND SAVE AND HOLD HARMLESS the releasee and each of them from any loss, liability, damage, or cost they may incur due to the presence of the undersigned in or upon the restricted area or in any way competing, officiating, observing, or working for, or for any purpose participating in the event and whether caused by the negligence of the releasee or otherwise.

HEREBY ASSUMES FULL RESPONSIBILITY FOR AND RISK OF BODILY INJURY, DEATH OR PROPERTY DAMAGE due to the negligence of releasee or otherwise while in or upon the restricted area and/or while competing, officiating, observing, or working for or for any purpose participating in the event.

THE UNDERSIGNED expressly acknowledges and agrees that the activities of the event are very dangerous and involve the risk of serious injury and/or death and/or property damage. THE UNDERSIGNED further expressly agrees that the foregoing release, waiver, and indemnity agreement is intended to be as broad and inclusive as is permitted by the law of the Province or State in which the event is conducted and that if any portion thereof is held invalid, it is agreed that the balance shall, notwithstanding, continue in full legal force and effect.
